In keeping with the club dress policy, jeans are not permitted on the courts. You'll want to wear what you can move around in without feeling constricted. Think clothing layers! As you generate body heat by playing, you will find yourself shedding a layer or possibly two or three! Tennis sneakers or footwear meant for cross training are best. Running and track shoes are NOT recommended for two reasons: they do not provide the lateral support necessary for your feet, and they tend to flare out on the sole, running the risk of catching that edge of the sole on the court and tripping the player.
